

Fire Evacuation

In brief, the manual evacuation chair **can't do**:

Stair angles greater than 42° or less than 28°, spiral steps, platforms smaller than 900mm x 900mm, nor go upstairs (unless physically lifted)

Benefits compared to competitor manual evacuation chairs:

It doubles as a transit chair on 4 wheels, easy to transfer into, very easy to operate, seat base tension can be altered to suit individuals, good balance and angle on stairs. Will take upto 150kg (24stone)

Benefits for using the Powered Stairclimbers:

Very easy to transfer into, gives good support to the individuals posture, will climb up or down stairs upto 160kg (25stone), can be used for access if lifts temporary breakdown, can be used on steep staircases, spirals and small platform areas.
